FAMILY PHILOSOPHY: As part of the Lakeview Home School Ministry, LEEP seeks to assist home school parents in teaching their children to follow the command in Matthew 22:37-39. "Jesus replied: 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

ORIENTATION MEETING: Parents agree to attend the meeting at Lakeview on Tuesday, July 11th @ 1:00-3:00 upstairs in west wing. Please contact individual teachers if unable to attend to get information.

ATTENDANCE: Make class time a priority. Please notify teacher of upcoming absences, or when the student is sick. Please call or text the class assistant if student will be late.

MISSED WORK: It will be the responsibility of each student to find out what was missed and to keep current. For in class activities that are missed, please contact the teacher.

PARENTAL SUPERVISION OF COURSE WORK: Go over the class syllabus with the student making sure that they understand what is expected and when homework assignments are due. The teachers may have classroom specific expectations. Commit to looking over student's work each week and making sure assignments are completed.

GRADES: In the Lakeview Educational Enrichment Program classes for younger students, teachers typically do not give grades. There will be feedback given on individual assignments but the parent will decide on overall grades.

ON CAMPUS CONDUCT: Students will not be allowed to roam the church building. Please observe designated drop-off and pick-up times and locations, which will be discussed at the July 11th meeting. If you miss the meeting, please make sure you understand the procedure.

-Cell phone use is strictly restricted to out of class use. -No technology including handheld gaming systems or ipods -Classroom behavior should be above reproach – no talking, disobeying the class rules, being disrespectful of teacher or inappropriate language at the discretion of the teacher. -Students should dress modestly and appropriately, which means no sleepwear, no spaghetti straps, and no shorts for girls. Only long pants, capris, or skirts to the knees are allowed. Shirt must overlap pants. If wearing leggings or tights, shirt/top must come down to mid-thigh. Boy's shorts must reach knees.

GROUNDS FOR DISMISSAL: Failure to adhere to the regulations outlined on this form constitutes grounds for dismissal. FEES: Students will not be permitted to class meetings if registration, tuition and late fees are not paid. Registration fees should be payable to Anne Ingram. Tuition fees should be payable to the teacher and turned in with the registration forms to Lakeview / LEEP. One-half first semester tuition is due by May 16th (registration-\$50 May 17-July11; \$75- after July 11) and the rest is due by the parent meeting on July 11th. Second semester tuition will be due along with registration fee of \$25 by late October unless full tuition was already paid. All fees are non-refundable once paid.
